(EU) No 10/2011; Specific Migration Limits (SML), including amendments to Annex I put forward in Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1442

This declaration is to inform GAIA BioMaterials AB's customers that products manufactured by GAIA fully comply with the Specific Migration Limits (SML) put forward in the Commission Regulation (EU) No 10/2011, and the amendments of Annex I of the aforementioned regulation by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/1442 of 11 July 2023, including but not limited to the below maximum levels:

- Hexamethylenediisocyanate (FCM-No 372) SML (T) = N.D.
 (1mg/kg in the final product, expressed as isocyanatemoiety)
- 1,4-Butanediol (FCM-No 254) SML (T) = 5mg/kg
- Terephthalic acid (FCM-No 785) SML (T) = 7.5mg/kg
- Tetrahydrofuran * (FCM-No 246) SML = 0.6mg/kg

Please note that the above statement is only valid for materials as delivered from GAIA in granular form. GAIA does not claim responsibility for the additional processing undertaken by the customer or on behalf of the customer. It is the customer's responsibility to test the end products for the above mentioned substances and limits.
